Digital Reform: Frequently asked questions

What is the digital edition of Reform?

It is a version of *Reform* magazine that you can read on electronic devices such as your computer, tablet or smartphone.

What does it have that the paper version doesn't?

If you access the digital version of *Reform* on a tablet, you can enjoy additional features, such as image galleries, video and audio.

The digital version also offers the following features to every reader, whether you read it on your computer, tablet or smartphone:

- Free access to an archive of digital back issues from February 2014 onwards;
- The ability to search and find any word/phrase from the present issue and the archive;
- Magnification of text and images;
- Live links to online documents, websites, email addresses and phone numbers.

How can I access the digital edition of Reform?

There are two different ways: Through an app on your tablet or smartphone, or through a website on your computer.

How can I access the digital edition of Reform on my tablet and/or smartphone?

To get the digital edition of *Reform* on your tablet and/or smartphone, you need to:

- download the *Reform* app for free; and
- pay for a subscription to the digital edition of *Reform* magazine.

You can download the free app and pay for the subscription by visiting www.exacteditions.com/reform on your tablet or smartphone.

How can I access the digital edition of Reform on my computer?

To get the digital edition of *Reform* on your computer, you need to:

- visit www.exacteditions.com/reform;
- pay for a subscription to the digital edition of *Reform*; you will be then be issued with login details;
- log in and read *Reform* on that website.

So long as your subscription is live, you can log in and read digital *Reform* at www.exacteditions.com/reform.

Where can I download the app?

Visit <u>www.exacteditions.com/reform</u> on your tablet or smartphone.

Do I have to subscribe for a whole year?

No, you can buy a three-month subscription to digital *Reform* for £6. (A 12-month subscription costs £18.) For the latest digital edition offers, please visit www.exacteditions.com/reform.

What if I'm already a subscriber to the paper magazine?

If you already subscribe to the paper version of *Reform*, you can pay a greatly reduced rate of £6 a year to add the digital magazine to your subscription. That's 80% off the cover price. To arrange this, contact *Reform*'s subscription customer service team on 01371 851 886 and they will organise this for you. You can also email customer services at subs@reform-magazine.co.uk.

My paper subscription is partway through. Do I have to wait till renewal before I can add digital *Reform* to my subscription?

No, you can subscribe today and start receiving it straightaway for 60p per issue. You can then buy a joint annual subscription to paper and digital, for an additional £6 on top of your paper subscription price, when you renew.

How much does the digital edition of *Reform* cost?

There are three different subscription options:

- Digital only, 12 months: £18
- Digital only, 3 months: £6
- Print + digital, 12 months: £6 on top of your paper subscription price (for UK subscribers this means £31 in total.)

If you are an existing subscriber partway through an annual paper subscription, you can add the digital edition to your subscription for 60p per issue until your renewal date.
